

The Pathology Department has actively organized a range of academic and co-curricular activities to enhance student engagement and learning. On 4th and 11th December 2023, a poster competition was conducted for the 2021 undergraduate batch, where all students participated and presented their work. The event encouraged creativity and academic expression, with the top three posters being recognized and appreciated.
